

Overview of Treetop Academics 'In Residence' Programs

<u>Treetop Academics Mission Statement</u>: By providing hands-on, project-based, curriculum in Art and Science, our programs aim to support and supplement site-based curriculum and provide new experiences and projects to students. Our 'In Residence' program aims to provide different academic enrichment experiences in either Art or Science that otherwise may not be feasible in the regular classroom setting. By working with students during the school day, our projects and lessons are designed to incorporate all learners and our lessons are differentiated corresponding to grades K-5. First, and foremost, with our 10-week student-centered curriculum and project experiences, students will be urged to explore, inspire their creativity, and challenge themselves within a framework designed for student success.

Schedule: Treetop Academics offers separate 10-week Art and Science 'In residence' programs for elementary students. This schedule may be adjusted based on specific needs of the school or classroom. There is a maximum of three 10-week terms in the academic year with Winter and Spring Break separating the three trimesters that we can provide programs.

<u>Instructors</u>: There are two Treetop Instructors for each class who will deliver enrichment instruction and work with regular classroom teachers to assist in the project/lesson. Treetop Academics will develop the lessons and curriculum as agreed upon. We will aim to make connections with both site-wide and classroom lessons to further student understanding as a course of academic enrichment.

<u>Cost:</u> We try to offer programs that are aligned with the direct needs of the school/classroom. Because this is the case, we also adjust cost based on the specific proposal of the school and therefore don't necessarily have a set rate. All our programs have the cost of the supplies built-in when we do give a quote.
