Employment Related Daycare, or ERDC, is a subsidy program run through Oregon's Department of Early Learning and Care (DELC) meant to help families pay for childcare. Treetop academics does accept ERDC subsidy as a form of payment for childcare. Please read through the following document for step by step information if you have ERDC already or are interested in receiving ERDC subsidies.

Enroll in Treetop

- 1. Fill out initial Treetop registration form Online: https://form.jotform.com/222636080122041
- 2. Watch for a confirmation email with Treetop enrollment packet
- 3. Fill out and send enrollment packet back, wait for confirmation email that we received your packet

Connecting ERDC Benefits to Treetop

- 1. You may now contact the Direct Payment Unit (DPU: This is the unit responsible for the payment side of the subsidy) and connect your case with Treetop as a provider

ERDC Minimum Requirements

- Live in Oregon
- Working/In-school/receiving TANF
- In a two-parent household both parents must be in working or in school to qualify, some exceptions made for parents with health conditions or supervised contact requirements
- In need of child care to keep working, attending school, or participating in well-being activities
- Have a child under 13 OR a child between the ages of 13-17 with special circumstances
- Meet income limits

Apply to Receive ERDC Benefits

Applying for ERDC benefits:

These are the steps required to apply to qualify for ERDC benefits, once this process is complete they will give you approval to connect to Treetop.

The Waitlist

- 1. ERDC currently has a waitlist due to increased demand and limited funding
- 2. This will not affect you if you are currently receiving services
- 3. Families can expect to wait 18-months or longer
- 4. Exemptions:
- Families recently or currently receiving Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) or Temporary Assistance for Domestic Violence Survivors (TA-DVS)
- Families referred by the Child Welfare Division of the Oregon Department of Human Services (ODHS)
- Families reapplying for ERDC within two months of benefits ending



How does ERDC work?

Once approved, here is what to expect:

- 1. You identify Treetop as your child care provider
- 2. DELC pays part of the bill, directly to Treetop
- 3. You will pay the remainder of the bill directly to Treetop

F.A.Q

- 1. What is Treetop's provider number?
 - a. ISS00015
- 2. Does treetop accept ERDC as a subsidy payment for Hackathons (No school day camps)?
 - a. Yes
- 3. If I have no co-pay, will ERDC still cover the cost of child care?
 - a. Yes, dependent on hours allocated by DELC. (An average amount is 70hrs per month)
